

**INSURANCE SPOUSAL WAIVER OF
DEATH BENEFIT CONSENT FORM**

You indicated on your insurance application that you are currently married; however, the primary beneficiary on the application form was not your spouse. Your State's community property law requires that you must obtain your spouse's consent for any designation that does not allow your spouse to receive the policy's death benefit. If your spouse agrees to waive this right, your spouse will need to complete and sign this waiver and have his or her signature notarized.
